



General Overview of Changes:

Version 8 of the Liquefied Petroleum Gas Safety On Site Guide sees the implementation of a NEW A4 format, replacing the smaller A5 guide that NICEIC has used for a number of years.

The move to A4 has many benefits over the A5 variant, and is the result of stakeholder engagement – training providers, gas installing businesses and individual gas engineers – on the effectiveness and usefulness of the Guides. As with previous versions of the Guide and separate to normal editorial changes on references, the following table outlines the technical amendments of Version 8:

Chapter/Section	Amendments
Chapter 3; 3.4.2	Updated information on gas engineers dealing with reports of fumes – overview provided of Supplement 1 to IGEM/G/11 and the greater detail contained within the Domestic Gas Safety On Site Guide
Chapter 6; 6.0.3	Minor update to include Caravan regulators operating at 30 mbar
Chapter 9; 9.6	Minor update to identify that there are situations where main protective bonding is not required and to seek further guidance from a competent electrical person
Chapter 11	Multiple changes within this Chapter addressing points of clarification with regards to BS EN 1949 – cylinder compartments; fixed LPG tanks (Liquid Gas UK's CoP 32); slide out installations (habitation compartments that can be pulled out to increase living space); high level ventilation provisions for Caravan Holiday Homes (including trickle ventilation for CHH that exceed 20 m2 floor area)
Chapter 13	Minor amends to the Introduction to condense and present the chronology of standards – BS 5483-3, PD 5482-3, PD 54823, BS EN ISO 10239 – via a concise table
